The EaP PLUS Project & its main activities



EaP PLUS: multi-level support actions

- 3 year long **Coordination & Support Action** funded from Horizon 2020 and dedicated to the EU – EaP STI cooperation (*Sept 1, 2016 – Aug 31, 2019*)
- Includes partners from all the 6 Eastern Partnership countries and from several EU MS

Objectives:

- I. Support to EU-EaP *Policy Dialogue*
- II. Foster interaction between EU-EaP researchers & *promote Horizon 2020*
- III. Enhance the EU-EaP *research-innovation* partnership

II. Interaction between EU-EaP researchers & promotion of H2020

- ✓ **Grants for EaP researchers** to attend Brokerage Events in EU or preparatory meetings for H2020 (<https://www.eap-plus.eu/>);
- ✓ **Info Days and Support to H2020 NCP Networks in all EaP Countries** (training, awareness campaigns for NCPs);
- ✓ **Targeted Cooperation with Scientific Diaspora** using input from IncoNet EaP (policies & national databases); organization of 6 Diaspora workshops
- ✓ **Development of Webinars** (11 for H2020; 6 for specific innovation related topics)

EaP Plus Grants for Networking

- **Grants support:** Research institutions, SMEs and Industry, Local authorities, Civil Society
- To **attend** either a Brokerage Event or a Preparatory Meeting
- Candidates can apply for one **event scheduled** Oct 2018 - 30 June, 2019
- **Final deadline** for submissions: **30 May 2019** (unless the available budget is consumed earlier)

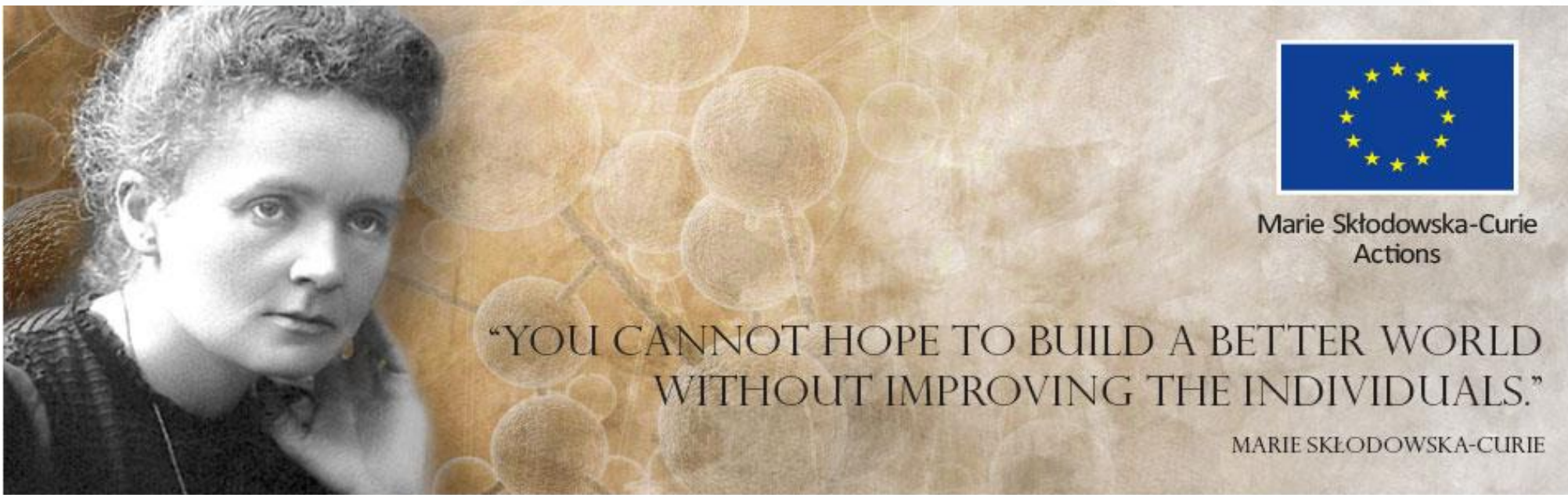

Objectives of Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions

Ensure optimum development and dynamic use of Europe's intellectual capital in order to generate new skills, knowledge and innovation

Key features of MSCA

WHAT?

- ***bottom-up*** approach
- **all domains of research and innovation** from basic research to market take-up and innovation services
- **transfer of knowledge** and **training** through research



Key features of MSCA

WHO?

- researchers of **any nationality**
- researchers, managers, administrative and technical personnel supporting project's research and innovation activities
- two categories of researchers: **ESR** and **ER**



Key features of MSCA

WHERE?

- **all types of organisations** from academic and non-academic sector: university, research institute, company, hospital, NGO,
- countries: **MS** (EU Member States) , **AC** (countries associated to H2020), **TC** (third countries)
- **eligibility condition: international mobility**

MSCA Institutions

ACADEMIC SECTOR

- public or private HEI awarding academic degrees
- public or private non-profit research organisations
- international European interest organisations

NON-ACADEMIC SECTOR

BENEFICIARIES

- **sign the Grant Agreement with the EC**
- responsible for executing all project activities, proposed research and training programme

PARTNER ORGANISATIONS

- **do not sign the Grant Agreement with the EC**
- do not recruit researchers
- involved in trainings and secondments
- claims costs back from a Beneficiary

MSCA Researchers

Researchers of any nationality
employed by the host organisation



Early Stage Researchers (ESR):

- less than 4 years of research experience
- no PhD degree

Experienced Researchers (ER):

- more than 4 years of research experience
- or PhD degree

MSC Actions

RESEARCHERS apply directly
to the EC in cooperation with hosting
organisation in EU/AC

IF

- Individual Fellowships

RISE

- Research & Innovative Staff Exchange

INSTITUTIONS
apply to the EC and later second
researchers

ITN

- Innovative Training Networks

COFUND

- Co-funding of regional, national, international programmes

What is RISE about?

George Bernard Shaw:

If you have an apple and I have an apple and we exchange these apples then you and I will still each have one apple.

But if you have an idea and I have an idea and we exchange these ideas, then each of us will have two ideas.



RISE features

OBJECTIVE

- ✓ promote international and inter-sector collaboration through research and innovation staff exchanges
- ✓ develop common culture of research and innovation

SCOPE

- ✓ international and inter-sector transfer of knowledge and sharing of ideas
- ✓ common research and innovation project
- ✓ highly-skilled research and innovation staff

EXPECTED IMPACT

- ✓ strengthen the interaction between organizations in the academic and non-academic sectors, and between Europe and third countries

RISE – main features

- ✓ Duration of projects: maximum 4 years
- ✓ Minimum eligibility condition: participants from 3 different countries (at least 2 EU MS/AC)
- ✓ Institutions representing academic and non-academic sector
- ✓ Support to secondments of staff members (1-12 months)
- ✓ Secondment must be international
- ✓ No secondments between institutions located outside Europe or within the same MS/AC
- ✓ Within Europe: only inter-sector secondments
- ✓ Maximum 540 researcher-months for secondment per consortium
- ✓ Partners from OTC (incl. USA) should envisage own budget for their seconded staff members

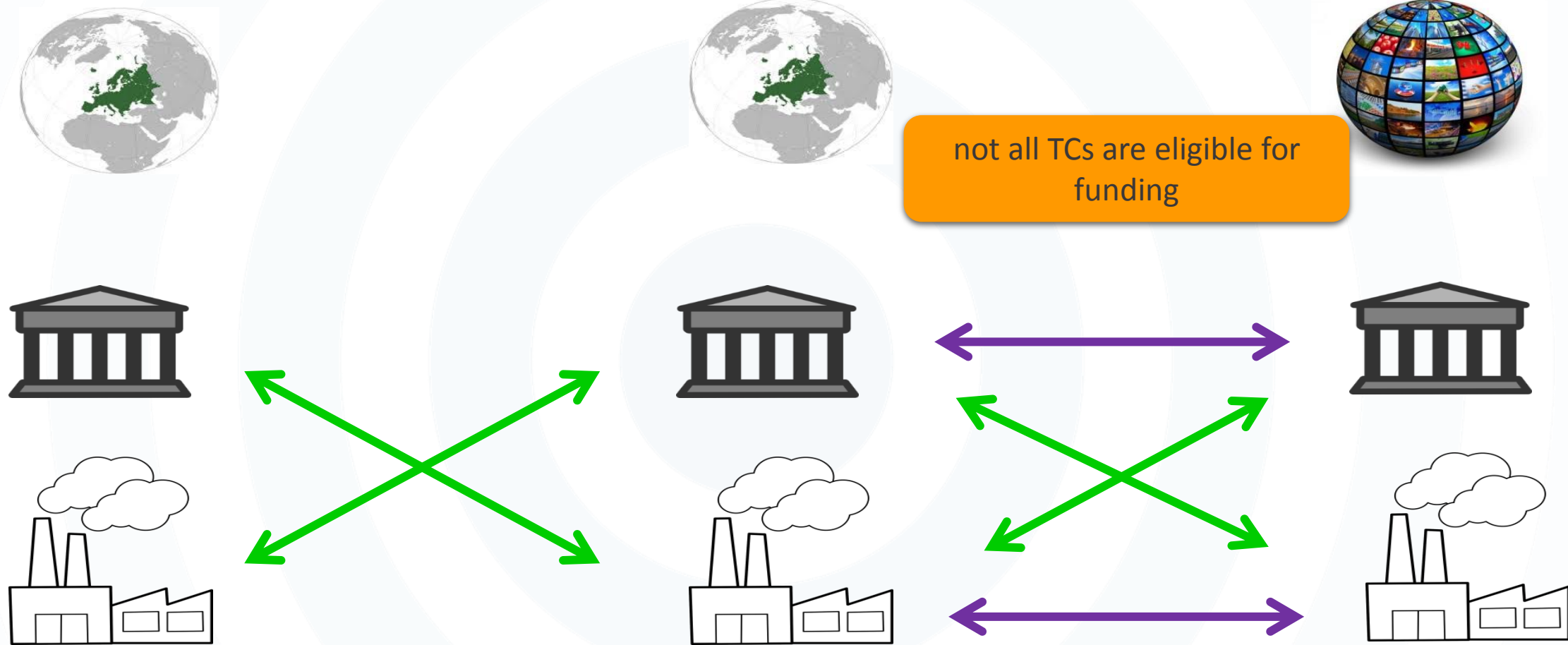
RISE – who is staff?

Staff must:

- ✓ **be considered staff of the sending organisation**
type of relationship applicable in a national law; staff must be under direct instructions of sending organisation during secondment
- ✓ **be actively engaged in – or linked to – R&I activities at the sending institution**
for at least one month (full-time equivalent and continuously) immediately prior to the first period of secondment
- ✓ **have one of the following research experience or staff profiles**
ESR – early-stage researchers; ER – experienced researchers
ADM – administrative; MNG – managerial; TECH – technical staff



RISE – secondments



RISE – budget breakdown

| Staff member unit cost (per month) | institutional unit costs (per month) | |
|---------------------------------------|---|-------------------------------|
| | research, training and networking costs | management and indirect costs |
| 2 100 € | 1 800 € | 700 € |

Top-up allowance to support travel, accommodation and subsistence costs for staff member during secondment

TC partners can claim these costs from European organisations activities carried out at their institutions


MSCA RISE

Opportunities for the TC partners in RISE project

- ✓ becoming a project partner
- ✓ taking part in research and innovation activities
- ✓ sending their own staff to Europe with EC funding for TC eligible for funding
- ✓ hosting researchers seconded from Europe
- ✓ getting involved in project management bodies
- ✓ claiming costs for research, training, networking & management, indirect and staff member unit costs
