RRI – Responsible research and innovation

Responsible research and innovation is a concept that runs through all of Horizon 2020 and is about conducting research and innovation in a way that takes into account societal needs and challenges.

RRI is an umbrella term for a number of SwafS concepts – gender, open access, science education, public engagement and ethics. It is also about ensuring research and innovation is accepted by everyone concerned and that it contributes to sustainable development. RRI shouldn't just be applied to outcomes and innovations but the whole research and innovation process as well.

The criteria are described in more detail in the definition of RRI developed by the EU project **RRI Tools**.
